

RESOLUTION NO. 522

WHEREAS, the Citizens of the City of Alexandria were saddened by the passing of former City Councilman John K. Pickens, on Monday, November 15, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the late Mr. Pickens was a devoted public servant, having served his community with distinction as City Councilman for six years, as Chairman of the Alexandria Archaeological Commission since its inception in March, 1975 until his death, and as former Chairman of the National Capital Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the late Mr. Pickens fostered archaeological research in the City, and some of the finds have been of important historical significance; and

WHEREAS, the late Mr. Pickens was a member of the Gadsby's Tavern American Legion Post, Kiwanis, Veterans of Foreign Wars and also a respected member of the legal profession.
