

RESOLUTION NO. 604

WHEREAS, one of the primary functions of local government is to assist its citizens to provide for their basic personal and family needs; and

WHEREAS, there are numerous human services programs and activities in which the City can participate in order to meet these needs of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, these human services activities need to be organized and coordinated in order to maximize the delivery of services to the recipients; and

WHEREAS, each local jurisdiction has individual needs which dictate how human services can best be delivered in that jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, supports Senate Bill No. 160 which would enable each local governing body to prepare and submit to the Governor for approval a locally-designed human services organization that would not otherwise be possible due to State regulations.

FURTHER RESOLVED that this legislation should not be used as a means to reduce or eliminate human services which are required by law.
