

RESOLUTION NO. 613

WHEREAS, the General Assembly appropriated 10 million dollars in 1977 to be allocated to rapid rail transit capital costs in Northern Virginia;

WHEREAS, by a communication dated February 21, 1978 said funds were released by the Governor to the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission to be applicable to the system as identified in the Interim Capital Contributions Agreement of March 1977;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said agreement relying on said action by the General Assembly the City of Alexandria made payments in the amount of \$5,053,000 to meet Alexandria's obligations pursuant to said agreement, \$1,685,000 of said payment being provided by a bond anticipatory note due on April 25, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria opposes allocation of said funds by the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority except in accordance with specific authorization by each member jurisdiction;

Now therefore be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Alexandria:

1. The Northern Virginia Transportation Commission be advised that it is the City Council's position that Alexandria's share of such funds, as computed in proportion to Alexandria's contributions under the capital contributions agreement, be allocated to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority only in accordance with specific authorization by the City Council of the City of Alexandria.

2. No part of Alexandria's share of such funds shall be used to reimburse the "advance of internally generated funds" utilized in said agreement until the debt identified by said bond anticipatory note or any substitute obligation thereof is discharged and the City Council by an affirmative vote authorizes such action.
