

ORDINANCE NO. 101

AN ORDINANCE Amending Ordinance No. 88. "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 64, Imposing License Taxes on Persons, Firms, Companies, Associations, and Corporations Conducting Business or Engaging in Professional Employment Within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and Providing for the Payment, Collection, Revocation and Regulation Thereof."

Be It Ordained by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That ordinance No. 88 of the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia, approved on the 23rd day of December, 1929, be amended by adding thereto Section 78-A as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 78-A. Water, heat, light and power companies. Water companies and heat, light and power companies (whether by means of electricity or gas) shall be required to pay an annual license tax of one-half of one percentum of the gross receipts of such business accruing to such companies from said business in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
