

ORDINANCE 107

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SOUTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY TO REMOVE ITS SWITCH FROM ITS WILKES STREET TRACK AT OR NEAR THE EAST SIDE OF WASHINGTON STREET AND TO INSTALL THE SAME AT A POINT EAST OF ST. ASAPH STREET AND TO CONNECT SAME WITH THE EAST END OF ITS PRESENT SWITCH OR SIDING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WILKES STREET.

WHEREAS, the Southern Railway Company is operating a switch from its Wilkes Street track beginning at a point at or near the east side of Washington Street and extending along the south side of Wilkes Street to a point at or near the west side of St. Asaph Street, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria wishes the said Southern Railway Company to remove the switch from Washington Street on account of improvements being made at that point in connection with the Mount Vernon Boulevard and to install the end of said switch on Wilkes Street at a point east of St. Asaph Street,

NOW, THEREFORE:

Section 1. Be it ordained by the City Council of Alexandria that the Southern Railway Company be, and it is hereby authorized to remove its switch from its Wilkes Street track at or near the east side of Washington Street and to install the same at a point east of St. Asaph Street, and to connect the same with the east end of its present switch or siding on the south side of Wilkes Street at or near the west side of St. Asaph Street, as shown on a blueprint on file in the office of the City Engineer.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force from its passage.
