

## ORDINANCE No. 110

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF APARTMENT HOUSES IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

Be It Ordained By the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. No apartment house shall hereafter be constructed or erected in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, of frame construction, but same shall be constructed of fire-resisting materials. Any building having more wood on the outside than is necessary for door and window frames, eaves and cornices, doors, shutters and outside steps, and any building constructed of wooden uprights faced with metal or wood laths upon which cement or stucco is applied, shall be considered frame construction.

Section 2. Any building used for the residential housing of more than two families is hereby defined as an apartment house.

Section 3. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a term not to exceed sixty days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
