

## Ordinance No. 119

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT BEGGING AND SOLICITING IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That no resident or non-resident of the City of Alexandria, whether able-bodied or not, shall beg or solicit money or other things of value in or upon the streets or other public ways of the City or from house to house without a written permit from the City Manager.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$20.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
