

ORDINANCE No. 100

AN ORDINANCE Providing Penalties for the Unnecessary and/or Wasteful Use of Water When an Emergency Has Been Declared to Exist in the Water Supply of Alexandria City.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, when an emergency has been declared to exist in the water supply of Alexandria City by published printed notice by the City Manager, to use water obtained from the mains supplying said City, for the watering of lawns, plants or flowers, (except plants or flowers grown by a duly licensed florist); the washing of automobiles, side walks or porches or any other unnecessary or wasteful use.

SECTION 2. Any violation hereof shall be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars, (\$10.00), nor more than Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00).

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
