ORDINANCE NO. 20.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PROFANE SWEARING AND DRUNKENNESS; HOW PUNISHED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. If any person having arrived at the age of discretion, profanely curse, swear or get drunk in public, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 21.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT SHOOTING OF FIREARMS IN A STREET, ALLEY, OR PUBLIC PLACE IN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. If any person shoot in or along any street or alley within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and if any person shoot in any place of public resort in said City, he shall, for each offense be fined not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 22.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ASSAULT AND BATTERY IN THE STREETS OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACE WITHIN THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall assault or beat any other person on the streets or other public places in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, except where such assault or battery shall be committed with legal provocation, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished in the discretion of the trial justice or the court trying such case, with a fine of not less than five nor more than fifty dollars or confinement in the City jail of not less than five days nor more than three months, or both.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
