

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, TO EMPLOY, IF NECESSARY, SPECIAL COUNSEL FOR ADVICE IN REFERENCE TO THE COLLECTION OF TAXES, LEVIES AND CHARGES ON REAL ESTATE DUE THE CITY AND FOR CONDUCTING NECESSARY LEGAL OR EQUITABLE PROCEEDINGS FOR THE CITY IN MAKING SAID COLLECTION, AND GIVING AUTHORITY TO SAID SPECIAL COUNSEL TO CONDUCT SAID PROCEEDINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

(1) That the City Manager be and he is hereby empowered and authorized to employ, if he shall deem it necessary, special counsel for the purpose of advice with reference to the collection of taxes, levies and other charges on real estate in the City of Alexandria due said City or to become due, and for the purpose of conducting the necessary legal or equitable proceedings for the City in enforcing or making said collection.

(2) That the said special counsel shall conduct any such legal or equitable proceedings as attorney for the City as provided by the laws of this Commonwealth or the Ordinances of this City.

(3) All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

(4) This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
