

## ORDINANCE NO. 216

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931:**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia: Section 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed in the following particulars, to-wit:

That the area of that tract of land, to-wit: BEGINNING at a point on Mt. Vernon Highway 37 feet 8½ inches North of the northeast corner of the intersection of Montgomery Street and said Mt. Vernon Highway; thence North 315 feet 5½ inches; thence East 246 feet 10 inches; thence south along St. Asaph Street 252 feet 2¼ inches; thence southwest to intersection of Mt. Vernon Highway and Montgomery Street, to point of beginning, be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast corner of Washington and Green Streets with a frontage on Washington Street of 100 feet and a depth extending eastward to St. Asaph Street, be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast corner of Gibbon and Columbus Streets be changed from "B" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
