

ORDINANCE NO. 219

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25, 1931, etc.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed in the following particulars to-wit:

"A" That the area of the square bounded by Alfred, Columbus, Green and Church Streets, be changed from "A" residence zone to "C" residence zone.

"B" That the area of those lots fronting on Russell Road between Mt. Ida Avenue and Pine Street be changed from "C" residence zone to "A" residence zone.

"C" That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast corner of Queen and Alfred Streets be changed from "B" residence zone to "D" commercial zone.

"D" That the area of the rear 122½ feet by the full depth thereof of Lot 2, Block 1 as shown upon 1930 assessment map 104 be changed from "C" residence zone to "D" commercial zone.

"E" That the area of Lots 982, 983 and 984 Del Ray be changed from "A" residence zone to "B" residence zone.

"F" That the area of that parcel of land bounded on the north by Cameron Street line, on the east by Sarah Baggett property, and on the south by King Street and on the west by Hooff's Run be changed from "C" residence zone to "D" commercial zone.

"G" That the area of that lot of ground located at the northeast corner of Patrick and Queen Streets be changed from "A" residence to "D" commercial zone.

"H" That the area of that lot of ground located at the southeast corner of Washington and Wilkes Street, now occupied by the Texas Oil Company, be changed from "A" residence zone to "D" commercial zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
