

ORDINANCE NO. 222

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia:

Section 1. That the zoning map described and referred to in Section 2 of Ordinance No. 109 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, approved July 25th, 1931, be changed in the following particulars, to-wit:

1. That the area of those lots or parcels of land known as Fagelson's Addition to Dempsey's Subdivision located on the north side of Bashford Lane and just west of the right-of-way of the Mount Vernon Memorial Highway and designated as Lots 4 to 38, inclusive, of said subdivision, with the exception of Lot 20 be changed from "A" Residence to "C" Residence Zone, and that the said Lot 20 of said Fagelson's Addition to Dempsey's Subdivision be changed from "A" Residence to "D" Commercial Zone.

2. That the area of that lot of ground located on the north side of Mason Avenue, commencing at a point 157 feet west of the west side of Mount Vernon Avenue and extending westwardly on Mason Avenue 157 feet by the full depth thereof of approximately 270 feet be changed from "B" Residence to "C" Residence Zone.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
