

## Ordinance No. 319

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE MOVING OR REMOVAL OF ANY BARRICADE OR OBSTRUCTION ERECTED BY THE FORCES OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, AND THE DRIVING OF ANY VEHICLE WITHIN A BARRICADED AREA, OR TO REMOVE OR MOLEST ANY LIGHTS, FLAGS OR MARKERS USED IN AND ABOUT SUCH AREA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to move or remove any barricade or obstruction erected or placed by the forces of the City of Alexandria to protect work in the course of construction, or any other necessary municipal purpose, and it shall further be unlawful for any person to drive any vehicle within a barricaded area, or to remove or molest any lights, flags or markers used in or about such area.

Section 2. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the day following its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
