

ORDINANCE NO. 323

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 321 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, known as the parking meter ordinance, by repealing and re-enacting Section 3 and Section 15 thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 321 of the City of Alexandria, approved June 25, 1940, be and it hereby is repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Section 3(a). The time limits for parking in any space in said parking meter zones shall be determined by deposit of coin or coins in each parking meter as follows, provided that the time limit for parking shall in no case exceed one hour:

Twelve (12) minutes for one cent (1c)
Twenty-four (24) minutes for two cents (2c)
Thirty-six (36) minutes for three cents (3c)
Forty-eight (48) minutes for four cents (4c)
One hour for five cents (5c)

(b) The hours of the day or night during which the parking meter restrictions shall be in force shall be determined by the Traffic Board of the City of Alexandria."

Section 2. That Section 15 of Ordinance No. 321 of the City of Alexandria, approved June 25, 1940, be and it hereby is repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

"Section 15. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance and any person who shall aid, abet or assist in the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than one dollar (\$1.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both, in the discretion of the court."

Section 3. That this ordinance shall become effective on the day after its publication in the Alexandria Gazette.
