

# Ordinance No. 1037

**AN ORDINANCE** authorizing the City Manager of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, to execute on behalf of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a Deed of Easement dated July 16, 1959, by which deed the Richmond Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company, a Virginia Corporation conveys to the City of Alexandria, a municipal corporation of Virginia, a storm water sewer easement over certain land in the City adjacent to Slaters Lane.

WHEREAS, the said railroad is willing to grant such an easement as evidenced by its execution of a Deed of Easement dated July 16, 1959, and,

WHEREAS, the said railroad has requested that the City Manager be authorized by ordinance to execute said Deed of Easement on behalf of the City, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Alexandria, a municipal corporation, a Deed of Easement dated July 16, 1959, wherein the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company, a Virginia corporation, conveys to the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a municipal corporation, an easement for storm water sewer purposes over certain lands of said railroad company as described in said deed and more particularly shown on a plat attached to said deed marked "Plat showing the land required for sewer easement purposes by the City of Alexandria, Virginia, from Richmond, Fredericksburg, and Potomac, Scale: 1" = 50', October 20, 1958, Department of Public Works."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
