

Ordinance No. 1038

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager of the City of Alexandria Virginia, to execute on behalf of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a Deed of Easement dated May 27, 1959, by which deed the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company, a Virginia Corporation conveys to the City of Alexandria, a municipal corporation of Virginia, an easement for the construction, maintenance and operation of passenger bus bays over certain land in the City in the vicinity of U.S. Route No. 1 and Potomac Yards.

WHEREAS, the said railroad is willing to grant such easements as evidenced by its execution of a Deed of Easement dated May 27, 1959, and,

WHEREAS, the said railroad has requested that the City Manager be authorized by ordinance to execute said Deed of Easement on behalf of the City, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Alexandria, a municipal corporation, a Deed of Easement dated May 27, 1959, wherein the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company, a Virginia corporation, conveys to the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a municipal corporation easements for the construction, maintenance and operation of passenger bus bays over certain lands of said railroad company as described in said deed and more particularly shown on a copy of a plat on file in the Office of the Department of Public Works of the City of Alexandria entitled "Land required for Street Widening by the City of Alexandria, Virginia, from R. F. & P. RAILROAD (Potomac Yard), Federal Aid Project No. U-103 (4), State Project No. 1600-70, Parcel No. 36" and made by Edward S. Holland, Certified Land Surveyor of Alexandria, Virginia, a copy of which plat is also attached to and made a part of said deed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
