

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Subsections (a) and (c), Section 31-79.78, Division 6, Article 1, Chapter 31 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which Chapter 31 relates to TAXI CABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE, which Article 1 relates to TAXI CABS AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLES, which Division 6 relates to FARES, which Section 31-79.78 relates to AMOUNT OF FARE TO BE CHARGED, and which Subsections (a) and (c) relate to CHARGES PER MILE AND FRACTIONS THEREOF.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Subsections (a) and (c), Section 31-79.78, Division 6, Article I, Chapter 31 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 31-79.78 Amount of Fare to be Charged.

- (a) For the first mile or fraction thereof for one passenger \_\_\_\_\_ \$0.50
- (c) For each additional one-fourth mile or fraction thereof for one or more passenger \_\_\_\_\_ 0.10

Section 2. There is hereby provided an adjustment period of 30 days from the effective date of this ordinance. During this period the new rate provided hereinabove shall be charged by the owners or drivers of taxi cabs equipped with taximeters set to operate at such new rate and the owners or drivers of taxi cabs not set to operate at such new rate shall continue to charge at the old rate as set out in this section prior to its amendment, but in any event all taxi cabs operating under authority of this chapter shall be equipped with meters adjusted to the new rate after the said adjustment period.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
