

Ordinance No. 1065

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 17-42, Article II, Chapter 17, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Section 17-42 relates to BOOTBLACKS, which Article II relates to REGULATORY LICENSES, and which Chapter 17 relates to LICENSES AND LICENSE TAXES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 17-42, Article II, Chapter 17, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

SEC. 17-42. Bootblacks.

Bootblacks or Shoe Shining Parlors which are located in the City shall pay for the privilege of doing business an annual license of ten dollars (\$10.00) for the first chair or seat and three dollars (\$3.00) apiece for each additional chair or seat, but in no event shall the total tax exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
