

Ordinance No. 1066

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE repealing Ordinance No. 1011 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and amending Article IV, Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by amending and reordaining Sections Numbered 17-90 and 17-91 and by adding to such article and chapter a new Section numbered 17-92.4; which Ordinance numbered 1011 was enacted to provide for the taxing of passenger vehicles, passenger vehicles for hire, and convertible vehicles, which Article IV relates to **MOTOR VEHICLES, TRUCKS AND TRAILERS, MOTORCYCLES**, which Chapter 17 relates to **LICENSES**, which Section 17-90 relates to **PASSENGER VEHICLES**, which Section 17-91 relates to **PASSENGER VEHICLES FOR HIRE**, and which new Section numbered 17-92.4 relates to **CONVERTIBLE VEHICLES**.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Alexandria passed Ordinance numbered 1011 in order to amend Sections 17-90 and 17-91 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, and

WHEREAS, the effect of Ordinance numbered 1011, as passed is not clear in that due to a typographical error, said ordinance mistakenly refers to Section 17-89 and 17-90 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, instead of Section 17-90 and 17-91 as was the intention of said City Council, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of said Council to correct this error by repeal of said ordinance and the passage of the ordinance in the form originally intended; now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1011 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, introduced on February 10, 1959, published on February 13, 1959, passed on February 24, 1959, and effective March 15, 1959, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That Section 17-90, Article IV, Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 17-90. PASSENGER VEHICLES.

On all vehicles designed for the transportation of passengers, and used regularly by local residents on the streets of this City, there shall be an annual license tax for each vehicle in the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). Each such vehicle shall be provided with a

proper City license tag which shall be attached securely to either the front or rear State license tag and kept in full view at all times.

Section 3. That Section 17-91, Article IV, Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 17-91. PASSENGER VEHICLES FOR HIRE.

The annual license tax on taxicabs shall be Thirty-two Dollars (\$32.00) on each vehicle. The annual license tax on automobiles for hire, sightseeing vehicles, ambulances, rented or leased passenger vehicles, and all other for-hire vehicles designed and used for the transportation of passengers, shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) on each vehicle.

Each such vehicle shall be provided with a proper City tag which shall be attached to the rear State license tag and kept in full view at all times.

Section 4. That Article IV, Chapter 17 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be, and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section numbered 17-92.4 thereto to read as follows:

Sec. 17-92.4. CONVERTIBLE VEHICLES.

On station wagons and sedan delivery trucks used regularly by local residents on the streets of this City or by persons regularly conducting a business or occupation in the City, and registered as convertible vehicles with the Commonwealth of Virginia, there shall be an annual license tax for each such vehicle in the amount of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00). Each such vehicle shall be provided with a proper City license tag bearing, among other things, the letters CONV., which tag shall be attached securely to either the front or rear state license tag and kept in full view at all times.

Section 5. That in the opinion of Council, an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE for the reason that 1960 license tags go on sale March 15, 1960, and it is necessary to avoid confusion in the sale or and enforcement of the use of said tags.

Section 6. The Clerk of the Council shall note that date of introduction and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
