

Ordinance No. 1070

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, to execute on behalf of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, an Agreement dated February 29, 1960, by which Agreement the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company, a Virginia corporation, allows said City to construct, maintain and operate on the rights of way of said railroad, poles and supports for the purpose of supporting traffic light signals at various street intersections in the City, subject, however, to various conditions and covenants.

WHEREAS, the City desires the right to construct, maintain and operate certain poles and supports on the rights of way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company in the City for the purpose of supporting traffic light signals at various intersections, and

WHEREAS, said railroad is willing to grant such right and has requested that the City Manager be authorized by ordinance to execute an Agreement on behalf of the City concerning such rights; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and hereby is authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a Municipal Corporation, an Agreement dated February 29, 1960, wherein the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company grants to the City of Alexandria Virginia, a Municipal Corporation, a license to construct, maintain and operate subject to various conditions and covenants, certain poles and supports on the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad Company rights of way within the City for the purpose of supporting traffic light signals.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
