

Ordinance No. 1075

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Section 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which said Section 35-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES AND ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 35 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and by mailing, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FOURTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Section 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35, of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the piece of property hereinafter listed is changed to the zone specified:

All of lots 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, block 3491, City of Alexandria Assessment Maps 37 and 46, 1958 edition, being legal lots 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the Robert Courtney Subdivision, being the north side of Courtney Drive paralleling the Southern Railway right-of-way and lying approximately 400' east of South Van Dorn Street, containing 4.442 acres, from I-1 Industrial Zone to I-2 Industrial Zone.

Section 2. That in the opinion of Council an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE for the reason that a delay in considering it may cause the only asphalt plant in the City to move from the City at the beginning of the street construction season, and the loss of such a large and vital industry would adversely effect the general welfare of Alexandria.

Section 3. That this EMERGENCY ORDINANCE shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
