

Ordinance No. 1089

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 1-10, 1-12 and 1-13, and subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), and (g) of Section 1-20, all of Chapter 1, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which Section 1-10 relates to BOUNDARY OF THE SECOND WARD, which Section 1-12 relates to BOUNDARY OF THE FOURTH WARD, which Section 1-13 relates to BOUNDARY OF THE FIFTH WARD, which Section 1-20 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES, which subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), and (g) relate to ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES IN THE FIRST THROUGH SEVENTH WARDS RESPECTIVELY, and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, is of the opinion that the population of the City has increased to such an extent that the wards, election districts and voting places in the City should be changed in order to comply with the applicable laws and to expedite the proper handling of voters at the forthcoming Presidential election and all subsequent elections; therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1-10, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 1-10. SECOND WARD.

The boundaries of the Second Ward shall be as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the City, then southwardly with the corporate line to the centerline of Crestwood Drive, then along the centerline of Crestwood Drive in a southeastwardly and eastwardly direction to the centerline of Valley Drive, then in a northwardly direction along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Beverley Drive, then eastwardly along the centerline of Beverley Drive, to the centerline of Wellington Road, then northwardly along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive, then eastwardly along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road, then with the center of Cameron Mills Road southwardly to the centerline of Braddock Road, then with the center of Braddock Road southeastwardly to the centerline of Lloyd's Lane, then with the center of Lloyd's Lane eastwardly to the center of Russell Road, then with the center of Russell Road northwardly to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue, then with the center of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the north corporate line, then with the corporate line westwardly to the northwest corner of the City.

Section 2. That Section 1-12, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 1-12. FOURTH WARD.

The boundaries of the Fourth Ward shall be as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of King Street with the centerline of Washington Street, thence westwardly and

northwestwardly with the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Radford Street, then northward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of Braddock Road, then westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of King Street, then westward along the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Quaker Lane, then southwardly with the centerline of Quaker Lane, to the centerline of Duke Street; thence east with the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of South Quaker Lane, then south with the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the Cameron Run and the South Corporate limits; then eastwardly with Cameron Run and Hunting Creek along the South Corporate limits to the centerline of Washington Street, then northwardly with the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of King Street.

Section 3. That Section 1-13, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Section 1-13. FIFTH WARD.

The boundaries of the Fifth Ward shall be as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of King Street and the west side of the south-bound track of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railway Company, then westwardly and northwestwardly with the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Radford Street then with the centerline of Radford Street, northwardly to the centerline of Quaker Lane, then with the centerline of Quaker Lane northwardly to the centerline of Crestwood Drive, then along the centerline of Crestwood in a southeastwardly and eastwardly direction to the centerline of Valley Drive, then in a northwardly direction along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Beverley Drive, then in an eastwardly direction along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Wellington Road, then northwardly along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive, then eastwardly along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road, then with the centerline of Cameron Mills Road southwardly to the centerline of Braddock Road, then with the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Lloyd's Lane, then with the centerline of Lloyd's Lane and Bellefonte eastwardly to the west side of the south-bound track of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railway Company, and then with the west side of the south-bound track of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railway Company southwardly to the centerline of King Street.

Section 4. That subparagraph (a) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) First Ward. Washington School Election District and Voting Place; Gadsby's Tavern Election District and Voting Place; Ficklin School Election District and Voting Place.

The First Ward shall be divided into Washington School Election District, Gadsby's Tavern Election District, and Ficklin School Election District.

The Washington School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the southern City boundary crosses the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of Wolfe Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wolfe Street to the centerline of South St. Asaph Street; thence southward along the centerline of St. Asaph Street to the centerline of Milkes Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to Hunting Creek; thence westward along the north line of Hunting Creek to the point of beginning.

The Gadsby's Tavern Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Washington and Wolfe Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the centerline of St. Asaph Street; thence northward along the centerline of St. Asaph Street to the centerline of Wolfe Street; thence westward along the centerline of Wolfe Street to the point of beginning.

The Ficklin School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Washington and Oronoco Streets, thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the northern boundary of the City; thence eastward along the northern City boundary to the Potomac River; thence southward along the Potomac River to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence westward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Washington School Election District shall be at the Washington School located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Wolfe and Washington Streets.

The Voting Place within the Gadsby's Tavern Election District shall be at the Gadsby's Tavern located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Cameron and North Royal Streets.

The Voting Place within the Ficklin School Election District shall be at the Ficklin School located at the southeast corner of the intersection of North Pitt and Second Streets.

Section 5. That subparagraph (b) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(b) Second Ward. George Mason School Election District and Voting Place; Beverley Hills Election District and Voting Place; Barrett School Election District and Voting Place; Agudas Achim Congregation Election District and Voting Place.

The Second Ward shall be divided into George Mason School Election District; Beverley Hills Election District, Barrett School Election District, and Agudas Achim Congregation Election District.

The George Mason School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Braddock Road and Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Russell Road; thence southward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Lloyd's Lane; thence westward along the centerline of Lloyd's Lane to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence northward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The Beverley Hills Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Four Mile Run and the centerline of Mount Vernon Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Mount Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence southward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad; thence due north to the northern City boundary at Four Mile Run; thence eastward along northern City boundary to the point of beginning.

The Barrett School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Chalfonte Drive and Cameron Mills Road; thence northward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad; thence due north to the northern City boundary at Four Mile Run; thence westward along the northern City boundary to the western boundary of the City; thence southward along the western boundary of the City to the centerline of Preston Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Preston Road to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Gunston Road; thence southward along the centerline of Gunston Road to the centerline of Chalfonte Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Chalfonte Drive to the point of beginning.

The Agudas Achim Congregation Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Chalfonte Drive and Cameron Mills Road thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Wellington Road, thence southward along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence westward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence southward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence southward along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the western City boundary at Quaker Lane; thence northward along the City Boundary to the centerline of Preston Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Preston Road to the centerline of Valley Drive;

thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Gunston Road; thence southward along the centerline of Gunston Road to the centerline of Chalfonte Drive; thence eastward along Chalfonte Drive to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the George Mason School Election District shall be at the George Mason School located at the west side of Cameron Mills Road, between Virginia Avenue and Monticello Boulevard.

The Voting Place within the Beverley Hills Election District shall be at the Beverley Hills Community Center located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Old Dominion Boulevard and Tennessee Avenue.

The Voting Place within the Barrett School Election District shall be at the Barrett School located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Valley Drive and the right-of-way of the Washington and Old Dominion Railroad.

The Voting Place within the Agudas Achim Congregation Election District shall be at the Agudas Achim Congregation located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Valley Drive and Allison Street.

Section 6. That subparagraph (c) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(c) Third Ward. Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District and Voting Place; Powhatan Election District and Voting Place.

The Third Ward shall be divided into Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District and Powhatan Election District.

The Cameron Street Recreation Center Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along this right-of-way line to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the centerline of Washington Street; thence southward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The Powhatan Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Oronoco Street and Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the northern City boundary; thence westward on said boundary to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward on the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Monroe Avenue; thence southward along the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad to the centerline of Oronoco Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Oronoco Street to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Cameron Street Recreation Center

Election District shall be at the Cameron Street Recreation Center located on the north side of Cameron Street at the intresection of Cameron Street and Harvard Street.

The Voting Place within the Powhatan Election District shall be at the Traffic Control Building located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Powhatan and Bernard Streets.

Section 7. That subparagraph (d) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(d) Fourth Ward. MacArthur School Election District and Voting Place; Prince Street School Election District and Voting Place; Robert E. Lee School Election District and Voting Place.

The Fourth Ward shall be divided into MacArthur School Election District, Prince Street School Election District and Robert E. Lee School Election District.

The MacArthur School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Quaker Lane and Duke Street; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Radford Street; thence southward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the western right-of-way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along this right-of-way line to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the point of beginning.

The Prince Street School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the centerline of King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the western, right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along the said right-of-way line to the centerline of South Quaker Lane; thence southward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the southern City boundary; thence eastward along said boundary to the centerline of Hooffs Run; thence northward along the centerline of Hooffs Run to a point where it would intersect with a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward in a straight line to the centerline of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the centerline of Wilkes Street to the point of beginning.

The Robert E. Lee School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence westward along the centerline

of Wilkes Street to its end; thence westward along a western protraction of the centerline of Wilkes Street to the centerline of Hooffs Run; thence southward along the centerline of Hooffs Run to the southern City boundary; thence eastward along said boundary to the centerline of South Washington Street; thence northward along the centerline of Washington Street to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the MacArthur School Election District shall be at the MacArthur School located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Janney's Lane and Yale Drive.

The Voting Place within the Prince Street School Election District shall be at the Prince Street School located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Patrick Street and Prince Street.

The Voting Place within the Robert E. Lee School Election District shall be at the Robert E. Lee School located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Patrick Street and Jefferson Street.

Section 8. That subparagraph (e) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(e) Fifth Ward. Maury School Election District and Voting Place; Fairlington Election District and Voting Place; George Washington High School Election District and Voting Place; Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District and Voting Place.

The Fifth Ward shall be divided into Maury School Election District, Fairlington Election District, George Washington High School Election District, and Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District.

The Maury School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward on a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street, said line being perpendicular to King Street; thence eastward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The Fairlington Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of King Street and Radford Street; thence northward along the centerline of Radford Street to the centerline of Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of Crestwood Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Crestwood Drive to the centerline of Valley Drive; thence northward along the centerline of Valley Drive to the centerline of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Wellington Road,

thence northward along the centerline of Wellington Road to the centerline of Beverley Drive, thence eastward along the centerline of Beverley Drive to the centerline of Cameron Mills Road; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Mills Road to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward along a line from the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the centerline of King Street; said line being perpendicular to King Street; thence westward along the centerline of King Street to the point of beginning.

The George Washington High School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence southward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue, thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence westward along the centerline of Braddock Road to the centerline of Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the point of beginning.

The Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Alexandria Avenue to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along said right-of-way line to the centerline of Monroe Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence westward along the centerline of Lloyd's Lane to the centerline of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Braddock Road to a point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Maury School Election District shall be at the Maury School located at the west side of Russell Road between Rucker Place and Walnut Street.

The Voting Place within the Fairlington Election District shall be at the Blessed Sacrament School located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Kenwood Avenue and Braddock Road.

The Voting Place within the George Washington High School Election District shall be at the George Washington High School located at the east side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, between Glendale Avenue and Braddock Road.

The Voting Place within Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be at the Immanuel Lutheran Church located on the northeast corner of the intersection of Russell Road and Bellaire Road.

Section 9. That subparagraph (f) of Section 1-20, Chapter 1 of

the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(f) Sixth Ward. No. 2 Firehouse Election District and Voting Place; Mt. Vernon School Election District and Voting Place; Cora Kelly School Election District and Voting Place.

The Sixth Ward shall be divided into No. 2 Firehouse Election District, Mt. Vernon School Election District, and Cora Kelly School Election District.

The No. 2 Firehouse Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Bellefonte Avenue and Jefferson Davis Highway; thence westward along the centerline of Bellefonte Avenue to the centerline of Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline of Clyde Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Clyde Avenue to the centerline of Uhler Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Uhler Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline of the Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the point of beginning.

The Mt. Vernon School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Mt. Ida Avenue and Russell Road; thence northward along the centerline of Russell Road to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Reed Avenue; thence eastward along the centerline of Reed Avenue to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence southward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Uhler Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Uhler Avenue to the centerline of Clyde Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Clyde Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the point of beginning.

The Cora Kelly School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of Uhler Avenue and Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Commonwealth Avenue to the centerline of Reed Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Reed Avenue to the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue; thence northward along the centerline of Mt. Vernon Avenue to the northern City boundary; thence eastward along said boundary to the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway; thence southward along the centerline of Jefferson Davis Highway to the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Mt. Ida Avenue to the centerline

of Uhler Avenue; thence westward along the centerline of Uhler Avenue to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the No. 2 Firehouse Election District shall be at the No. 2 Firehouse located at the south side of Windsor Avenue between Mt. Vernon Avenue and De Witt Avenue.

The Voting Place within the Mt. Vernon School Election District shall be at the Mt. Vernon School located at the west side of Mt. Vernon Avenue, between Uhler Avenue and Randolph Street.

The Voting Place within the Cora Kelly School Election District shall be at the Cora Kelly School located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Reed Avenue and Commonwealth Avenue.

Section 10. That subparagraph (g), of Section 1-20, Chapter 1, of the Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(g) Seventh Ward. Minnie Howard School Election District and Voting Place; Patrick Henry School Election District and Voting Place.

The Minnie Howard School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the centerline of the intersection of South Quaker Lane and the southern boundary of the City; thence northward along the centerline of South Quaker Lane to the centerline of Duke Street; thence westward along the centerline of Duke Street to the centerline of Quaker Lane; thence northward along the centerline of Quaker Lane to the centerline of King Street; thence northward along the centerline of King Street to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the centerline of said highway to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along Jordan Street to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to Cameron Run; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the point of beginning.

The Patrick Henry School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right-of-way and Cameron Run on the southern City boundary; thence westward along said boundary and along the western City boundary to the centerline of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the centerline of said highway to the western property line extended of the Francis Hammond High School; thence leaving the centerline of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and following the west boundary of the Francis Hammond High School extended, and the southwest boundary of the said high school property to its intersection with the centerline of Pegram Street; thence eastward with the centerline of North Pegram Street to the centerline of North Pickett Street; thence northward along the centerline of North Pickett Street to the centerline of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the centerline of Seminary Road to the centerline of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the center-

line of Jordan Street to the centerline of Holmes Run; thence southward along the centerline of Holmes Run to the centerline of Cameron Run; thence southward along the centerline of Cameron Run to the point of beginning.

The Voting Place within the Minnie Howard School Election District shall be at the Minnie Howard School located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Braddock Road and North Early Street.

The Voting Place within the Patrick Henry School Election District shall be at the Patrick Henry School located on the north side of Taney Avenue between Latham Street and Howard Street.

Section 11. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
