

Ordinance No. 1090

AN ORDINANCE appropriating and allotting the sum of \$287,102.03 for making alterations and additions to the City Hall of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, a sizeable addition to City Hall is under construction and certain alterations are also being made in the City Hall; and

WHEREAS, funds are needed to complete such construction and alterations; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the sale of land to the Commonwealth of Virginia, there is available to the City the sum of \$287,102.03 unencumbered and unappropriated, which sum can be used for said construction and alteration; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$287,102.03 be, and the same hereby is, appropriated and allotted to the Alterations and Additions Account to be used for the additions and alterations that are presently being made to the City Hall of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
