

Ordinance No. 1092

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of an unnamed street adjacent to Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has approved the vacation of the hereinafter described portion of an unnamed street adjacent to Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park and,

WHEREAS, the viewers appointed by the City Council have recommended the vacation of the hereinafter described portion of an unnamed street adjacent to Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park and,

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law for such vacation have been followed and,

WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that the hereinafter described portion of an unnamed street adjacent to Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park is no longer required for public use and it is in the best interest to abandon it.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of an unnamed street adjacent to Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park, being a 20 foot wide street or alley lying between Lots 12, 13, 14 and 15 of Dye's Addition to Jefferson Park and the land of the Church Schools of the Diocese of Virginia, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly side of Fontaine Street and the land of the Church Schools of the Diocese of Virginia (St. Agnes School), and running thence with the land of the Church Schools of the Diocese of Virginia S. 17° 43' 30" E. to the intersection therewith of the northerly side of Thomas Street extended; thence with the northerly line of Thomas Street extended N. 76° 33' 30" W. to Lot 15 of Dye's First Addition to Jefferson Park; thence with the westerly and northwesterly boundary lines of Lots 15, 14, 13 and 12 of Dye's First Addition to Jefferson Park to the southerly side of Fontaine Street; thence with the southerly side of Fontaine Street N. 69° 50' 30" E. to the beginning.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
