

Ordinance No. 1127

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the owners and their successors in title to maintain an encroachment of a garage located on premises known and designated as 508 Upland Place, in, upon, and over Summit Lane, a public street of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, until such garage is destroyed or removed.

WHEREAS, Taylor Burke, Jr. and Jean R. Burke are the owners of that certain lot of ground together with the improvements thereon known, designated and numbered 508 Upland Place in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and

WHEREAS, a garage located thereon encroaches in, upon and over Summit Lane for a depth of from 0.25 feet to 0.32 feet, more or less, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that the continuance of said encroachment until the above mentioned garage is destroyed or removed will not be detrimental to the public interest, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the said Taylor Burke, Jr. and Jean R. Burke and their successors in title, be and they hereby are authorized to maintain and continue such encroachment on the aforementioned street, namely Summit Lane, as it now exists until the above mentioned garage is destroyed or removed, provided the authority hereby granted shall not be construed to relieve said owners of any negligence on their part on account of such encroachment.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
