

# Ordinance No. 1131

**AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 9A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding a new section thereto numbered 9A-3.1, which Chapter 9A relates to ETHICS, and which new section numbered 9A-3.1 relates to ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS REQUIRED.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 9A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new section thereto numbered 9A-3.1 to read as follows:

## Section 9A-3.1. **ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS REQUIRED**

Council appointees on boards, commissions, authorities and committees shall make an earnest effort in the performance of their duties and shall attend at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the meetings of the bodies on which they serve in each year unless they have an excuse good in the opinion of the City Council.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall forward a copy of this ORDINANCE to all present Council appointees serving on boards, commissions, authorities and committees and shall forward a copy of this ORDINANCE to all future Council appointees at the time of their appointment.
