

Ordinance No. 1142

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CITY OF ALEXANDRIA ORDINANCE NUMBERED 1128 ADOPTED JUNE 27, 1961, WHICH ORDINANCE NUMBERED 1128 RELATES TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA; AND TO INSTRUCT V. FLOYD WILLIAMS, CITY ATTORNEY, AND ROBERT J. McCANDLISH, JR., SPECIAL COUNSEL, TO WITHDRAW THE ANNEXATION PROCEEDING INSTITUTED AS A RESULT OF THE INSTUCTIONS CONTAINED IN SAID ORDINANCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Ordinance Numbered 1128, entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8 OF THE TITLE 15 OF THE CODE OF VIRGINIA, 1950, AS AMENDED, BY THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA"; adopted June 27, 1961, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That V. Floyd Williams, City Attorney, and Robert J. McCandlish, Jr., Special Counsel, be and they hereby are instructed to withdraw the annexation proceeding now pending as Law No. 10141 in the Circuit Court of the County of Fairfax, Virginia.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
