

Ordinance No. 1146

AN ORDINANCE to vacate an unused unnamed twenty-five (25) foot wide public street running from Stevenson Avenue to Lincolnia Road in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has approved the vacation of the hereinafter described twenty-five (25) foot wide street; and

WHEREAS, the viewers appointed by the City Council have recommended the vacation of the hereinafter described twenty-five (25) foot wide street; and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law for such vacations have been followed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the hereinafter described twenty-five (25) foot wide street is no longer required for use as a public street and it is in the best interest to abandon it; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a twenty-five (25) foot wide unnamed public street running from Stevenson Avenue to Lincolnia Road in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, the centerline of which is hereinafter described, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned.

Beginning at a point marking the intersection of the South line of Stevenson Avenue, 60 feet wide, with the centerline herein described, said point lying North 76° 33' 40" West, 46.82 feet from a Virginia Department of Highways Monument and running thence South 06° 27' 05" West, 276.87 feet to Point "B" as shown on the plat incorporated herein, said Point "B" lying in the westerly line of Lincolnia Road North 27° 54' 50" East, 27.17 feet from the Point of curve #3 in said westerly line of Lincolnia Road, all of which is more particularly shown on a plat entitled "Boundary Survey (Including Release Parcels) of the land of WALTER C. ROBBINS, JR., TR." dated November 20th, 1961, prepared by the office of Edward S. Holland, Professional Civil Engineer and Certified Land Surveyor, which plat is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
