

Ordinance No. 1152

AN ORDINANCE to amend The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding thereto a new chapter numbered 8A, which new chapter numbered 8A relates to and ADOPTS DAY-LIGHT SAVING TIME.

WHEREAS, the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia provide that the City of Alexandria, being in the Tenth Congressional District, may, by ordinance, establish Daylight Saving Time to be effective between the last Sunday in April and the last Sunday in October of each year; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Alexandria deems it expedient and necessary for the conduct of affairs and business of citizens of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that Daylight Saving Time be effective in the City to correspond with Daylight Saving Time in the City of Washington and Northern Virginia; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new chapter numbered 8A to read:

CHAPTER 8A DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

Sec. 8A-1. Year 1962

That Daylight Saving Time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, between 2:00 A.M. April 29th, 1962 and 2:00 A.M. October 28th, 1962, and shall be in effect within the entire corporate limits of the City.

Sec. 8A-2. Years subsequent to 1962

That Daylight Saving Time be and the same hereby is adopted as the official time of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, between the last Sunday in April and the last Sunday in October of each and every calendar year hereafter until otherwise changed by law. Daylight Saving Time shall begin and end on said Sundays each year simultaneously with said time in the City of Washington, District of Columbia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
