

# Ordinance No. 1165

**AN ORDINANCE to vacate a 120 foot portion of Fourth Street, one of the public streets of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, reserving therein, however, a storm sewer easement for the City of Alexandria, Virginia.**

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, provided that evidence of said vacation be recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law have been followed, and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of said viewers recommending said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of the public street above mentioned and hereinafter described is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same, reserving however, to the City the storm sewer easement hereinafter described.

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. That the hereinafter described portion of Fourth Street, a public street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned, subject, however, to the storm sewer easement reserved as described hereinafter:

All of that portion of Fourth Street running in a southerly direction from the south right of way line of Alexandria Avenue a distance of 120 feet to the north line of a 10 foot alley, said portion of Fourth Street being located in Park Addition Subdivision.

LESS AND EXCEPT, however, a reservation of a 10 foot wide sewer easement running the entire length of the 120 foot portion of Fourth Street vacated by this ordinance, the centerline of which said easement is located 10.5 feet west of and parallel to the existing centerline of Fourth Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective upon its being recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, subsequent to its final passage.
