

Ordinance No. 1170

AN ORDINANCE to repeal Ordinance numbered 290 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and all amendments thereto, which Ordinance numbered 290 was adopted May 23, 1939, and made effective July 21, 1939, and is known as the BUILDING CODE OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, and which amendments thereto made changes in said Ordinance numbered 290 and said Building Code.

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is adopting a new Building Code and the old Building Code as set forth in Ordinance numbered 290, and all amendments thereto, are no longer needed except for a transition period, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Ordinance numbered 290 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, known as the Building Code of Alexandria, Virginia, adopted May 23, 1939, and made effective July 21, 1939, and all amendments thereto, be and the same hereby are repealed and are no longer of any force or effect. Provided, however, that any and all buildings and structures for which a permit shall have been regularly issued by the Building Inspector before this ordinance takes effect may be completed in accordance with said permit, and in accordance with the plans submitted and approved, and under the provisions of the old Building Code of Alexandria in effect at the time such permit was issued and such plans approved. Provided, further that until December 12, 1962, plans for buildings and structures may be submitted in accordance with the old Building Code of Alexandria, and if approved and a permit is issued said buildings or structures may be completed in accordance with said permit and the plans submitted and approved, and under the provisions of the old Building Code of Alexandria. No plans shall be submitted for approval under the old Building Code after December 12, 1962.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
