

Ordinance No. 1177

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a walkway in Beverley Hills subdivision in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law have been followed, and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of the said viewers recommending said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the walkway above mentioned and hereinafter described in Beverley Hills subdivision is not needed for public use, and that it is in the public interest to vacate the same.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described walkway in Beverley Hills subdivision in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

All of the walkway lying between lots numbered 6 and 7, of Section 7, and lying also between lots numbered 20 and 21, of Section 8, Beverley Hills subdivision, as the same is shown on plats recorded in Deed Book 161, at page 575 and in Deed Book 170, at page 360, among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, which said walkway is 10 feet wide and approximately 243 feet long, and runs from the northerly line of Old Dominion Boulevard (formerly Virginia Boulevard) to the southerly line of Halcyon Drive.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
