

Ordinance No. 1199

AN ORDINANCE to vacate an unnamed thirty (30) foot wide public street running from Stevenson Avenue to the easterly line of Shirley Highway in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has approved the vacation of the hereinafter described thirty (30) foot wide street, and

WHEREAS, the viewers appointed by the City Council have recommended the vacation of the hereinafter described thirty (30) foot wide street, and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law for such vacations have been followed, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that the hereinafter described thirty (30) foot wide street is no longer required for use as a public street and it is in the best interest of the City to abandon it, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the thirty (30) foot wide unnamed public street running from Stevenson Avenue to Shirley Highway in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, the center line of which is hereinafter described, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at a point (Point "D"), marking the intersection of the north line of Stevenson Avenue, (60 feet wide) with the centerline herein described, said Point "D" lying N. 06° 27' 05" E. 60.45 feet from Point "C" (the northernmost point in the centerline of a roadway previously vacated by Ordinance No. 1146); running thence from Point "D" N. 06° 27' 05" E. 259.5 feet to Point "E", which said point lies in the easterly line of Shirley Highway, all of which said points, distances and directions are more particularly shown and described on a plat entitled "Abandoned and unused 30 foot public road to be vacated through the lands of John H. Grover & D. O. Myatt, Tr. & Alma Keyes & L. S. Keyes, et al.," dated December 7, 1962, prepared by the office of Edward S. Holland, Professional Civil Engineer and Certified Land Surveyor, which plat is incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this ordinance, and which said plat is on file in the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
