

Ordinance No. 1227

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 12-32, Article II, Chapter 12 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Chapter 12 relates to FIRE PREVENTION, which Article II relates to EXPLOSIVES, and which Section 12-32 relates to INTERPRETATION OF ARTICLE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 12-32, Article II, Chapter 12 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 12-32. Interpretation of article.

Nothing in this article shall be held to mean and include any small arms or signal rocket, or devices or compositions used to obtain visible or audible pyrotechnic effects, which are covered in sections 12-41 to 12-45.10 of this chapter, nor to include explosives in the forms prescribed in the official United States Pharmacopeia.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
