

Ordinance No. 1231

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend the MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, as adopted by ordinance numbered 1173 effective June 26, 1962.

WHEREAS, there has been some question about the status of North Pickett Street, between Duke Street and Holmes Run, as shown on the Major Thoroughfare Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has adopted a resolution recommending that North Pickett Street, between Duke Street and Holmes Run, be deleted from the Major Thoroughfare Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is also of the opinion that said street should be deleted from said Plan; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Major Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Alexandria, Virginia, shown on a map entitled "MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA," dated February, 1962, which was adopted as a part of the Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, by ordinance numbered 1173 on June 26, 1962, be and the same hereby is amended by deleting therefrom North Pickett Street between Duke Street and Holms Run.

Section 2. That in the opinion of the Council an emergency exists and this is declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE for the reason that a delay in the passage of this ordinance would cause unnecessary hardship on a property owner due to an inadvertance by the City. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
