

Ordinance No. 1235

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended; which said Section 35-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES AND ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 35 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and by mailing, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FIFTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Section 35-3, Article II, Chapter 35 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the piece of property hereinafter listed is changed to the zone specified:

BEGINNING at an original stone at the N. W. Corner of Nellie L. Butts tract, a corner adjacent to section 4 and 3 GLENMORE, thence along line of Section 4 and 3 GLENMORE S. 16° 16' W. 551 feet more or less to a point, thence along line of R-B and R-5 zoning, S 74° 50' E. 626 feet more or less to the W. line of Cowling now or formerly, thence N 15° 15' E 350 feet more or less to line of Umholtz now or formerly, thence N. 57' W. 329 feet more or less and N. 17° 14' W. 155.9 feet more or less to south line of Section 4 GLENMORE, thence with said line N 84° 23' W. 241.40 feet to point of beginning, containing 6 acres more or less, being part of lots 17, 18, 20, Block 6, Map 231 from R-5 Single-Family Residential to R-B Multi-Family Residential.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
