

Ordinance No. 1238

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (241); which Chapter 7 constitutes THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, which Section 7-8 relates to CHANGES IN BOCA CODE and which new subsection (241) amends BOCA CODE Section 620.1 relating to SMOKEPROOF TOWERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (241), to read as follows:

(241) Section 620.1 is amended to read:

620.1 Where Required.—In every mercantile (use group C), industrial (use group D), and assembly buildings other than theatres (use groups F-2, F-3 and F-4), over six (6) stories or seventy-five (75) feet in height, at least one (1) required means of egress shall be a smokeproof tower.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
