

Ordinance No. 1244

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 19-225, Article X, Chapter 19 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, which Chapter 19 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article X relates to BAD WEATHER, and which Section 19-225 relates to SNOW EMERGENCY PLAN NO. 4—PARKING.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the last paragraph of Section 19-225, Article X, Chapter 19 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1953, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

On any street or portion thereof designated a Snow Emergency Route and marked by special red and white signs not less than eighteen (18) inches wide, posted on at least two (2) posts in a block, no person shall, while Snow Emergency Plan No. 4 is in effect, park or permit any vehicle to remain parked on any such street. The parking prohibition shall remain in effect until Snow Emergency Plan No. 4 has been terminated by the City Manager or his authorized representative.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
