

Ordinance No. 1255

AN ORDINANCE to amend the MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered an amendment to the Major Thoroughfare Plan of the City, which amendment would change the status of portions of Trinity Drive, Princeton Boulevard and Dartmouth Road between North Quaker Lane and North Taylor Run Parkway, East; and

WHEREAS, the Commission deferred action in order to obtain clarification as to possible legal problems; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the matter and is of the opinion that there are no legal problems of consequence and that the Plan should be amended; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Major Thoroughfare Plan for the City of Alexandria, Virginia, shown on a map entitled "MAJOR THOROUGHFARE PLAN, CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA," dated February 1962, which was adopted as a part of the Master Plan of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, by Ordinance numbered 1173, and amendments thereto, be and the same hereby is amended as follows:

The 1200, 1300 and 1400 blocks of Trinity Drive, that portion of the 300 block of Princeton Boulevard which lies between its intersection with Trinity Drive and Dartmouth Road, and the 2700, 2800, 2900, 3000, 1000, and 1100 blocks of Dartmouth Road, all being further described as a collector road extending from the east line of North Quaker Lane to the west line of North Taylor Run Parkway, East, be and the same hereby are deleted as a collector road and established as a local street;

provided, however, that proposed portion of Dartmouth Road that lies between the east line of Crown View Drive extended and a point approximately 145.27 feet west of the center line of Skyhill Road be and the same hereby is deleted in its entirety from the Major Thoroughfare Plan.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
