

Ordinance No. 1260

AN ORDINANCE to vacate Summit Lane, an unopened and unused public way in George Washington Park Subdivision, Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings, and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law have been followed, and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report, and

WHEREAS, on consideration of the report of the said viewers recommending the said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the unopened and unused public way known as Summit Lane, hereinabove mentioned and hereinafter described, in George Washington Park Subdivision, is not needed for public use, and that it is in the public interest to vacate said public way.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described unopened and unused public way known as Summit Lane, George Washington Park Subdivision, which extends from the southwest side of Hilltop Terrace to the 600 Block of Upland Place in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at a point in the westerly line of Hilltop Terrace and at the southeasterly corner of Block 9, Section No. 2, George Washington Park as shown on plat recorded in Deed Book 95, Page 2, of the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia; thence with the westerly line of Hilltop Terrace S. 39° 31' 20" E. 15.00 ft. to a point at the northeasterly corner of Block 8, Section No. 1, George Washington Park; thence with the line of said Block 8, S. 50° 28' 40" W. 140.04 ft. and S. 89° 16' W. 64.09 ft. to a point at the southeasterly corner of Lot 2, Block 9, Section No. 2, of the said George Washington Park; thence with the easterly line of said Lot 2, N. 39° 31' 20" W. 74.85 ft. to a point in the southerly line of Upland Place; thence with the southerly line of Upland Place N. 50° 28' 40" E. 10.00 ft. to a point at the northwesterly corner of Lot 3, Block 9, Section No. 2, George Washington Park; thence with the westerly line of said Lot 3, S. 39° 31' 20" E. 70.45 ft. to a point at the southwesterly corner of the said Lot 3; thence with the southerly line of said Lot 3 and continuing with the southerly line of Lots 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, of the said Block 9, Section No. 2, George Washington Park N. 89° 16' E. 47.18 ft. and N. 50° 28' 40" E. 143.23 ft. to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of the publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
