

# Ordinance No. 1264

**AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 28-3, Article I, of Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, which said Section 28-3 relates to CONSTRUCTED SO AS TO REQUIRE SEPARATE AND DIRECT SERVICE FOR EACH HOUSE, BUILDING OR PARCEL OF PROPERTY, which said Article I relates to SEWAGE DISPOSAL AND DRAINS, IN GENERAL, and which said Chapter 28 relates to SEWAGE DISPOSAL AND DRAINS.**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 28-3, Article I, of Chapter 28 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

**SEC. 28-3. CONSTRUCTED SO AS TO REQUIRE SEPARATE AND DIRECT SERVICE FOR EACH HOUSE, BUILDING OR PARCEL OF PROPERTY.**

Any extension of the sewer system from sewers now built or hereafter built shall be constructed so that each house, building or separate parcel of property that connects with or is served by or through any part of the city sewer system shall be connected separately and directly with the city system, when and after the full amount required by section 28-5 of this Code has been paid into the city treasury, in accordance with provisions of section 25-31.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the late of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
