

Ordinance No. 1290

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of Old Columbia Road, a public right of way, located in the Jefferson Park Subdivision in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, reserving all utility easements lying with the said portion herein vacated.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law have been followed; and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the report of the said viewers recommending the said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, that the portion of Old Columbia Road, the public way hereinabove mentioned and hereinafter described, in Jefferson Park Subdivision, is not needed for public use, and that it is in the public interest to vacate the said public way while reserving all utility easements lying within the said portion herein vacated.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described public way known as Old Columbia Road in Jefferson Park Subdivision, within the City of Alexandria, Virginia, which extends from the southerly side of Columbia Road to the previously vacated part of Old Columbia Road, and is bounded by Lots 24, 25 and 26 of the said Subdivision, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned, provided however that all utility easements lying within the hereinafter described portion of Old Columbia Road are reserved.

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly side of Columbia Road with the westerly side of Old Columbia Road, said point being also the northeasterly corner of Lot No. 25, Block No. 1, of Jefferson Park Subdivision; thence running along the easterly boundary of said Lot No. 25 and thence the northerly boundary of Lot No. 26 to a point, said point being the southwesterly corner of a previously vacated part of Old Columbia Road; thence running along the westerly side of said vacation to the common southerly corner of Lots No. 24 and No. 23 of the aforementioned subdivision; thence running along the southerly and then westerly boundary of said Lot No. 24 to a point on the southerly side of Columbia Road, said point being also the most northwesterly corner of Lot No. 24; thence running along the southerly side of Columbia Road to the point of beginning.

It is the intent of this instrument to vacate all that portion of Old Columbia Road bounded by the southerly side of Columbia Road, the previously vacated part of Old Columbia Road, and Lots 24, 25 and 26 of the above mentioned subdivision, retaining, however, all utility easements lying within the above described vacation.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
