

Ordinance No. 1299

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a part of North Payne Street, lying between the north line of Wythe Street and the south line of Madison Street, located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, State of Virginia, and being more particularly described as follows:

Payne Street to be vacated between Madison Street and Wythe Street and more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at a point in the southerly line of Madison Street, said point marking the easterly line of Payne Street; thence with the said easterly line of Payne Street S 09° 30' W 353.17 feet to a point marking the northerly line of Wythe Street; thence with the said northerly line of Wythe Street, crossing Payne Street N 80° 39' W 66.17 feet to a point in the westerly line of Payne Street; thence with the said westerly line of Payne Street N 09° 30' E 353.17 feet to a point in the southerly line of the aforementioned Madison Street; thence with the said southerly line of Madison Street, crossing of Payne Street S 80° 39' E 66.17 feet to the point and place of beginning containing 23,369 Square Feet or 0.5364 Acres.

WHEREAS, such vacation has been duly approved by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for such vacation and for appointment of viewers was posted at the front door of the courthouse of the Corporation Court of the City of Alexandria, Virginia on the 15th day of September, 1964, at two public places in the City and more than ten days before viewers were appointed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, said viewers did duly report in writing on November 16, 1964, their opinion that no inconvenience would result from such vacation of such portion of said street and discontinuing the same; and the council having duly considered such report and other evidence at a public hearing after the land proprietors affected thereby, along the portion of said alley proposed to be vacated, had been duly notified;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinabove described part of North Payne Street located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same is hereby discontinued, vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in the newspaper of general circulation in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, in the manner prescribed by law, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
