

Ordinance No. 1364

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 20-46 of Article II and Sections 20-73 and 20-75 of Article III, all of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 20 relates to LICENSES, which Article II relates to REGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 20-46 relates to COIN-OPERATED DEVICES—SLOT MACHINES, which Article III relates to NONREGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 20-73 relates to PROFESSIONAL OCCUPATIONS AND BUSINESSES, and which Section 20-75 relates to BUSINESS SERVICES AND OCCUPATIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 20-46 of Article II of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new exception paragraph to read as follows:

On such coin operated machines or devices used for shining shoes, and more commonly known as shoe shine machines, there is hereby levied a license tax of \$5.00 per year for each such machine or device.

Section 2. That Section 20-73 of Article III of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new category to read as follows:

Consultants in the preparation of tax returns.

The same to be listed in appropriate alphabetical order.

Section 3. That Section 20-75 of Article III of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new category to read as follows:

Travel bureaus and agencies.

The same to be listed in appropriate alphabetical order.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1966.
