

Ordinance No. 1375

AN ORDINANCE to vacate certain public alleys and a court located in the city square bounded by King, North Fayette, Cameron and North Henry Streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, such alleys and such court being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the south side of Cameron Street 85.42 ft. west of Henry Street and at the east side of an alley; thence with the east side of said alley S. 9° 30' W. 39.17 ft. to an offset in the said alley; thence S. 80° 41' E. 1.42 ft. to the east side of the said alley; thence continuing with the east side of the said alley S. 9° 30' W. 19.67 ft. to the south end of the said alley; thence running across the south end of the said alley N. 80° 41' W. 10.00 ft. to the west side of the same; thence with the west side of the alley N. 9° E. 58.84 ft. to the south side of Cameron Street; thence with the same S. 80° 41' E. 8.58 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 533 sq. ft.

BEGINNING at a point in the east side of Fayette Street 100.00 ft. south of Cameron Street and at the north side of an alley; thence with the north side of said alley S. 80° 41' E. 154.08 ft. to the west side of another alley; thence with the west side of said alley N. 9° 30' E. 21.59 ft. to the north end of the said alley; thence running across the north end of the said alley S. 80° 41' E. 10.00 ft. to the east side of the same; thence running with the east side of the alley in part and the east side of a court in part S. 9° 30' W. 59.00 ft. to an offset in the said court; thence N. 80° 41' W. 10.00 ft. to a point; thence with the east side of the said court S. 9° 30' W. 9.17 ft. to the south end of the said court; thence running across the south end of the said court N. 80° 41' W. 30.66 ft. to the west side of the same; thence with the west side of the said court N. 9° 30' E. 36.88 ft. to the south side of the first mentioned alley; thence with the south side of the first mentioned alley N. 80° 41' W. 123.42 ft. to the east side of Fayette Street; thence with the same N. 9° 30' E. 10.00 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 3252 sq. ft.

WHEREAS, such vacation has been duly approved by the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, a notice of application for such vacation and for appointment of Viewers was posted at the front door of the

courthouse of the Corporation Court of the City of Alexandria, Virginia on the 1st day of December, 1965 and at two public places in the City of Alexandria and more than ten days before Viewers were appointed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, said Viewers did duly report in writing on December 21, 1965, their opinion that no inconvenience would result from such vacation of such alleys and court and discontinuing the same; and the Council having duly considered said report and other evidence at a public hearing after the land proprietors affected thereby, along the said alleys and court proposed to be vacated had been duly notified;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinabove described alleys and court located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia be and the same are hereby discontinued, vacated and abandoned.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
