

Ordinance No. 1377

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, which said Section 42-3 relates to ZONE BOUNDARIES: ADOPTION OF ZONING MAPS, which said Article II relates to ZONES AND GENERAL PROVISIONS, and which said Chapter 42 relates to ZONING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and by mailing, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the "FIFTH REVISED ZONING MAP" described and referred to in Section 42-3, Article II, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended in the particulars following so that the pieces of property hereinafter listed are changed to the respective zones specified:

- A. All of Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6, and part of Lots 1 and 10, Block 7, City of Alexandria Assessment Map 146, 1963 Edition, located on the west side of the 600 block of South Union Street between Gibbon and Franklin Streets, and containing approximately 1.23 acres;
FROM: I-1, Light Industrial
TO: RM, Single-family
- B. All of Parcels 1 and 02, Block 3535, City of Alexandria Assessment Map 47, 1963 Edition, located on the west side of Lincolnia Road, between Edsall Road and Duke Street, containing 1.2 acres;
FROM: R-5, Single-family
TO: C-2-B, Commercial Business
- C. All of Parcels 01 and 03, Block 3550, City of Alexandria Assessment Map 52, 1963 Edition, located on the south side of Edsall Road adjoining the western city limits, containing 3.3 acres.
FROM: R-8, Single-family
TO: RA, Multi-family

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction, together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
