

# Ordinance No. 1385

**AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subparagraphs (d), (e), and (g) of Section 1-17 of Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which subparagraph (d) relates to the FOURTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN; which subparagraph (e) relates to the FIFTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN; which subparagraph (g) relates to the SEVENTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN; which Section 1-17 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES; and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS.**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:**

Section 1. That subparagraph (d), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(d) Fourth Ward. MacArthur School Election District and voting place; Bishop Ireton School Election District and voting place; Prince Street School Election District and voting place; Robert E. Lee School Election District and voting place.

The fourth ward shall be divided into MacArthur School Election District, Bishop Ireton School Election District, Prince Street School Election District and Robert E. Lee School Election District.

(1) The MacArthur School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where the center line of Quaker Lane intersects with a line 50 feet south of the center line of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence northward along the center line of Quaker Lane to the center line of King Street; thence eastward along the center line of King Street to the center line of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the center line of Braddock Road to the center line of Radford Street; thence southward along the center line of Radford Street to the center line of King Street; thence eastward along the center line of King Street to the line 50 feet south of the center line of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence westward along the said line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the MacArthur School Election District shall be the MacArthur School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Janney's Lane and Yale Drive.

All persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, and whose residences bear a Janney's Lane mailing

address are included within the MacArthur School Election District.

(2) The Bishop Ireton School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point where a line 50 feet south of the center line of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane intersects with the center line of King Street; thence eastward along the center line of King Street to the western right of way of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along the right of way line to the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to the center line of Duke Street; thence westward along the center line of Duke Street to the center line of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of North Quaker Lane to the line 50 feet south of the center line of Janney's Lane and parallel with Janney's Lane; thence eastward along the said line to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Bishop Ireton School Election District shall be the Bishop Ireton School, at 201 Cambridge Road.

Those persons whose residences abut on the south side of Janney's Lane, but who do not have a Janney's Lane mailing address, are included within the Bishop Ireton School Election District, even though a portion of their residence may not be within the boundary of that district.

(3) The Prince Street School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence northward along the center line of South Washington Street to the center line of King Street; thence westward along the center line of King Street to the western right of way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along such right of way line to the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence southward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to the southern city boundary; thence eastward along such boundary to the center line of Hooffs Run; thence northward along the center line of Hooffs Run to a point where it would intersect with a western protraction of the center line of Wilkes Street; thence eastward in a straight line to the center line of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the center line of Wilkes Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Prince Street School Election District shall be at the Prince Street School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Patrick Street and Prince Street.

(4) The Robert E. Lee School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence westward along the center line of Wilkes Street to its end; thence westward along a western protraction of the center line of Wilkes Street to the center line of Hooffs Run; thence southward along the center line of Hooffs Run to the southern city boundary; thence eastward along such boundary to the center line of South Washington Street; thence northward along the center line of South Washington Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Robert E. Lee School Election District shall be at the Robert E. Lee School, located at the southwest corner of the intersection of South Patrick Street and Jefferson Street.

Section 2. That subparagraph (e), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(e) Fifth Ward. Maury School Election District and voting place; Blessed Sacrament Election District and voting place; First Assembly Election District and voting place; George Washington High School Election District and voting place; and Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District and voting place.

The fifth ward shall be divided into the Maury School Election District, the Blessed Sacrament Election District, the First Assembly Election District, the George Washington High School Election District and the Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District.

(1) The Maury School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of King Street and the western right of way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along such right of way line to the center line of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the center line of Commonwealth Avenue to the center line of Braddock Road; thence westward along the center line of Braddock Road to the center line of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the center line of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward on a line from the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the center line of King Street; such line being perpendicular to King Street; thence eastward along the center line of King Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Maury School Election District shall be at the Maury School, located on the west side of Russell Road between Rucker Place and Walnut Street.

(2) The Blessed Sacrament Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the Intersection of Braddock

Road and Radford Street; thence northward along the center line of Radford Street to the center line of Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of Quaker Lane to the center line of Crestwood Drive; thence eastward along the center line of Crestwood Drive to the center line of Valley Drive; thence northward along the center line of Valley Drive to the center line of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the center line of Beverley Drive to the center line of Wellington Road; thence northward along the center line of Wellington Road to the center line of Beverley Drive; thence eastward along the center line of Beverley Drive to the center line of Cameron Mills Road; thence southward along the center line of Cameron Mills Road to the center line of Braddock Road; thence westward along the center line of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Blessed Sacrament Election District shall be the Blessed Sacrament School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Kenwood Avenue and Braddock Road.

(3) The First Assembly Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of King Street and Radford Street; thence northward along the center line of Radford Street to the center line of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the center line of Braddock Road to the center line of Alexandria Avenue; thence southward along the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the center line of Timber Branch Parkway; thence southward along a line from the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the center line of King Street, said line being perpendicular to King Street; thence westward along the center line of King Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the First Assembly Election District shall be the First Assembly of God Church Youth Building, 700 West Braddock Road.

(4) The George Washington High School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the western right of way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence southward along such right of way line to the center line of Commonwealth Avenue; thence northward along the center line of Commonwealth Avenue to the center line of Braddock Road; thence westward along the center line of Braddock Road to the center line of Russell Road; thence northward along the center line of Russell Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the George Washington High School Election District shall be at the George Washington High School,

located on the east side of Mt. Vernon Avenue between Glendale Avenue and Braddock Road.

(5) The Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of Alexandria Avenue and Russell Road; thence eastward along the center line of Alexandria Avenue to the western right of way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad; thence northward along such right of way line to the center line of Monroe Avenue; thence northward along the center line of Jefferson Davis Highway to the center line of Bellefonte Avenue; thence westward along the center line of Bellefonte Avenue to the center line of Russell Road; thence westward along the center line of Lloyd's Lane to the center line of Braddock Road; thence eastward along the center line of Braddock Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Immanuel Lutheran Church Election District shall be the Immanuel Lutheran Church, 1801 Russell Road.

Section 3. That subparagraph (g), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(g) Seventh Ward. Minnie Howard School Election District and voting place; Francis Hammond High School Election District and voting place; Patrick Henry School Election District and voting place; Temple Beth El Election District and voting place.

The seventh ward shall be divided into the Minnie Howard School Election District, the Francis Hammond High School Election District, the Patrick Henry School Election District and the Temple Beth El Election District.

(1) The Minnie Howard School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of North Quaker Lane and Seminary Road; thence northward along the center line of Quaker Lane to the Arlington County line; thence westward along the Arlington County line to the center line of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence southward along the center line of said highway to the center line of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the center line of Seminary Road to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Minnie Howard School Election District shall be the Minnie Howard School, located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Braddock Road and North Early Street.

(2) The Francis Hammond High School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of the intersection of the center line of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway with the center line of Seminary Road; thence eastward along the center line of Seminary Road to the center line of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the center line of North Jordan Street to a point on a line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue; thence westward along the line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue to the east boundary of the Patrick Henry School property; thence northward along the east boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to the northeast corner of the said property; thence westward along the north boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to the northwest corner of the said property; thence southward along the west boundary of the Patrick Henry School property to its intersection with the line 50 feet north of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue; thence westward along the line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue to the center line of the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the center line of the said highway to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Francis Hammond High School Election District shall be the Francis Hammond High School, 4646 Seminary Road.

Those persons whose residences abut on the north side of Taney Avenue between the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and North Jordan Street, but who do not have a Taney Avenue mailing address, are included within the Francis Hammond High School Election District, even though a portion of their residence is not within the boundary of that district.

(3) The Patrick Henry School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right of way and Cameron Run on the southern city boundary; thence westward along the southern city boundary and northward along the western city boundary to the center line of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the center line of the said highway to the line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue; thence eastward along the line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue and parallel with Taney Avenue to the western boundary of the Patrick Henry School property; thence northward along the said western boundary to the northwest corner of the said property; thence eastward along the north boundary of the said property to its northeast corner; thence southward along the eastern boundary of the said property to its intersection with the line 50 feet north of the center line of Taney Avenue

and parallel with Taney Avenue; thence eastward along the said line to the center line of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the center line of North and South Jordan Streets to the center line of Holmes Run; thence southward along the center line of Holmes Run to the center line of Cameron Run; thence southward along the center line of Cameron Run to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Patrick Henry School Election District shall be the Patrick Henry School, located on the north side of Taney Avenue between Latham Street and Howard Street.

All persons whose residences abut on the north side of Taney Avenue between the Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway and North Jordan Street, and who have a Taney Avenue mailing address are included within the Patrick Henry School Election District.

(4) The Temple Beth El Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of South Quaker Lane and the southern boundary of the city; thence northward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to the center line of Duke Street; thence westward along the center line of Duke Street to the center line of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of North Quaker Lane to the center line of Seminary Road; thence westward along the center line of Seminary Road to the center line of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the center line of North and South Jordan Streets to the center line of Holmes Run; thence southward along the center line of Holmes Run to the center line of Cameron Run; thence southward along the center line of Cameron Run to the southern boundary of the city; thence eastward along the southern boundary of the city to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Temple Beth El Election District shall be Temple Beth El, 3830 Seminary Road.

Section 4. That upon the passage of this ordinance the Director of the Department of General Services shall cause copies of this ordinance to be posted at the front door of the Courthouse and at each voting place in each election district affected, for a period of at least thirty (30) days prior to the next election.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
