

Ordinance No. 1396

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection (5) of subsection (g) of Section 42-27 of Article V of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article V relates to OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING GENERALLY, which Section 42-27 relates to OFF-STREET PARKING GENERALLY, which subsection (g) thereof relates to SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS, and which subsection (5) thereof relates to TOURIST COURTS, HOTELS OR MOTELS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (5) of subsection (g) of Section 42-27 of Article V of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(g) Schedule of requirements.

(5) Tourist courts, hotels or motels—One space for each guest room or dwelling unit; except, that for buildings over three stories in height, one space for each two guest rooms or dwelling units; provided that on sites for which preliminary site plans have been approved after July 6, 1966, one space for each guest room or dwelling unit plus one employee parking space for each fifteen guest rooms or dwelling units, or major fraction thereof.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
