

Ordinance No. 1426

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-193, Article VIII, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Section 22-193 relates to SAME—POLICE, FIRE AND AMBULANCE SIRENS, which Article VIII relates to BRAKES, HORNS AND OTHER MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT, and which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-193, Article VIII of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-193. Same—Police, fire and ambulance sirens.

Every police vehicle and fire department vehicle and every ambulance or rescue vehicle used for emergency calls shall be equipped with a siren, exhaust whistle, or air horn designed to give automatically intermittent signals, of a type not prohibited by the superintendent of the department of state police.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
